





3 Prophecies Fulfilled by Jesus' Crucifixion

Prophecy	Old Testament	New Testament
Be mocked and insulted by many	"All who see me mock me; they hurl insults, shaking their heads."—Ps. 22:7 (Also Ps. 22:8, 17)	"Those who passed by hurled insults at [Jesus] The chief priests and the teachers of the law mocked him." —Mark 15:29–32 (Also Matt. 27:31, 39–43; Luke 23:35–39)
Be pierced when crucified	"they pierce my hands and my feet."—Ps. 22:16 "They will look on me, the one they have pierced" —Zech. 12:10	[Thomas said,] "Unless I see the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe." —John 20:25 "[Jesus] said to Thomas, 'Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe.'" —John 20:27 (Also Matt. 27:35; John 19:34–37)




