


DAY 7: God rests

God creates the world and everything in it. GEN. 1:1–2:25

- Adam and Eve eat the forbidden fruit, sin enters the world, and they are banished from the Garden of Eden. Gen. 3:1–24
- Cain murders Abel. GEN. 4:1-16
- The human race multiplies and sinfulness increases. GEN. 6:1–7
- ◆ God instructs Noah to build an ark. GEN. 6:13-7:5
- God sends a flood which destroys everyone except Noah, his family, and the animals in the ark. GEN. 7:6–8:19
- God sends a rainbow as a sign of his covenant with Noah. GEN. 8:20-9:17
- God confuses the peoples' languages at the tower of Babel. GEN. 11:1-9

- Terah, Abram's father, settles the family in Haran.
 GEN. 11:27–32
- Abram obeys God's call to go to Canaan. GEN. 12:1-3
- (1) God's first promise to Abram: God will bless Abram, make him into a great nation, and all people will be blessed through him. GEN. 12:1-3
- (2) God's second promise to Abram: God will give the land of Canaan to Abram's descendants. Gen. 12:7
- Abram and his wife Sarai move to Egypt because of a famine. GEN. 12:10–20
- (3) God's third promise to Abram: Abram's descendants will be as numerous as dust. GEN. 13:14–17
- (4) God's fourth promise to Abram: Abram and Sarai will bear a son and his descendants will be as numerous as the stars. GEN. 15:1–20

- Unable to bear a child, Sarai gives her slave Hagar to Abram. Hagar gives birth to a son, Ishmael. GEN. 16:1–16
- (5) God's fifth promise to Abram: Sarai will bear a son who will be named Isaac. God changes Abram's name to Abraham ("father of many") and Sarai to Sarah ("princess"). GEN. 17:1–21
- (6) God's sixth promise to Abraham: Three visitors promise to Abraham that Sarah will bear a son within one year. GEN. 18:1–15
- God destroys Sodom and Gomorrah but rescues Abraham's nephew Lot and his family. GEN. 19:1–29
- Abraham travels to Gerar where he tells King Abimelech that his wife Sarah is his sister. GEN. 20:1–18

2100 BC

- Joseph's jealous brothers sell him into slavery. GEN. 37:1-35
- In Egypt, Joseph becomes a slave of Potiphar, a captain of Pharaoh's guard. GEN. 37:36
- Potiphar's wife falsely accuses Joseph and he is thrown into prison.
 GEN. 39:1–20
- Joseph interprets dreams in prison and then Pharaoh's dream.
 GEN. 40:1–41:40
- Joseph is made an official in Egypt. GEN. 41:41–43
- Joseph's brothers travel from Canaan to Egypt to buy food during a famine. GEN. 42:1–3
- Joseph tests his brothers, reveals his identity, and forgives them.
 GEN. 44:1–45:14
- Jacob's family settles in Egypt. GEN. 46:1–7
- ◆ Jacob blesses his sons before his death. GEN. 49:1-28
- Joseph dies in Egypt at 110 years old. GEN. 50:22–26

 Israelites (Hebrews) are in Egypt for about 400 years, part of that time in slavery. Ex. 1:1–14



1600 B

- Pharaoh enslaves the Hebrews and orders all male Hebrew newborns to be killed. Ex. 1:15–17, 22
- Moses' family places baby Moses in a basket in the Nile River to escape being killed. Ex. 2:1–2
- Moses is rescued out of the Nile and raised by Pharaoh's daughter. Ex. 2:5–10
- Moses kills an Egyptian who was beating a Hebrew. Ex. 2:11–14
- Moses flees to Midian, marries, and becomes a shepherd. Ex. 2:15-22
- God speaks to Moses through a burning bush. Ex. 2:22–3:9
- At God's command, Moses returns to Egypt with his brother Aaron and they confront Pharaoh to let God's people go. Ex. 5:1–6
- God sends ten plagues upon Egypt until Pharaoh relents. The first Passover is observed. Ex. 7:14–12:30

- The promised son, Isaac ("laughter"), is miraculously born to Abraham and Sarah. GEN. 21:8–21
- Abraham sends Hagar and Ishmael away, and God provides for them. GEN. 21:8–21
- God tests Abraham by commanding him to sacrifice Isaac. But God stops Abraham and provides a ram as the sacrifice instead. GEN. 22:1–14
- (7) God's seventh promise to Abraham: His
 descendants will take possession of their enemies'
 cities. GEN. 22:15–18
- Sarah dies at age 127. GEN. 23:1–20
- Abraham's servant finds a wife for Isaac: Rebekah. GEN. 24:1–67
- Abraham dies at age 175. GEN. 25:1-11

- Rebekah bears twin sons: Esau and Jacob. GEN 25:19–26
- ◆ Esau sells his birthright to Jacob for a bowl of stew. GEN. 25:27–34



- Jacob deceives his father into giving him the blessing of the firstborn that was rightfully Esau's. GEN. 27:1–28:9
- Jacob marries Leah and Rachel and has twelve sons. GEN. 29:15–30

- Jacob wrestles with the angel of the Lord and is renamed Israel ("struggles with God"). GEN. 32:22-32
- After years of estrangement, Jacob and Esau reconcile. GEN. 33:1–16
- Rachel dies near Bethlehem while giving birth to her son Benjamin. GEN. 35:16–20




